AMB TRANX 160 transponders will be used throughout the event for all Lap scoring of heats, pre final and final.. Personal transponders may be used. Please include your AMB seven digit number on the AKA scrutineering form and confirm this number at entry confirmation

NOTE: Transponders are available for use (until July 2010)

METHOD OF RACING:

Under Subscribed Classes

Heats 1 & 2 – 10 Laps, Pre-final - 14 Laps, Final - 16 Laps.

Pre-drawn grid for 1st Heat. Reverse grid for 2nd Heat

Combined points from heats determines grid position of pre final

Finishing order of pre final determines grid position for the final

Final only counts on the day.

Over-subscribed classes:

Heats 1 & 2 – 10 Laps, Pre-final - 14 Laps, Final - 16 Laps

Class will split into two groups of even quantity groups A & B

Pre-drawn grid for 1st Heat. Reverse grid for 2nd Heat for the two groups

- a. Heat 1 (Group A)
- b. Heat 1 (Group B)
- c. Heat 2 (Group A)
- d. Heat 2 (Group B)

Only the **Top thirty six (36)** placed competitors to progress to finals.

Grid positions for Pre- Final are based on the points gained during the 2 Heats. Driver with the highest points to grid 1, next to grid 2 and so on up to track capacity, compete in the Pre Final. Drivers with equal points up to track capacity, grid positions will be determined by highest points finishing position.

Finishing order of pre final determines grid position for the final

Final only counts on the day.

Prizes

Trophies awarded to **1st, 2nd and 3rd** placegetters.

ALL STAR SERIES Prizes for a Yamaha Engine & Set of Tyres for each class will be a random draw for all drivers (must complete all four rounds to be eligible to go in to the draw) Each class must have 12 starters at each round. Trophies awarded to 1st 2nd & 3rd placegetters at completion of the series at the VKA Presentation Night 11th December 2010 and venue TBA

Blue and Red Double Diagonal flag **will** be used during this meeting.

Weights/Fuel/Tyres As per 2010 AKA Manual and Amendments.

Number of Starters Maximum number of karts per each event is 36.

Track Closure/Track will be closed to all entrants for practice from Monday to Thursday inclusive. Gates will be open on Friday for Unofficial Practise & Pit set up.

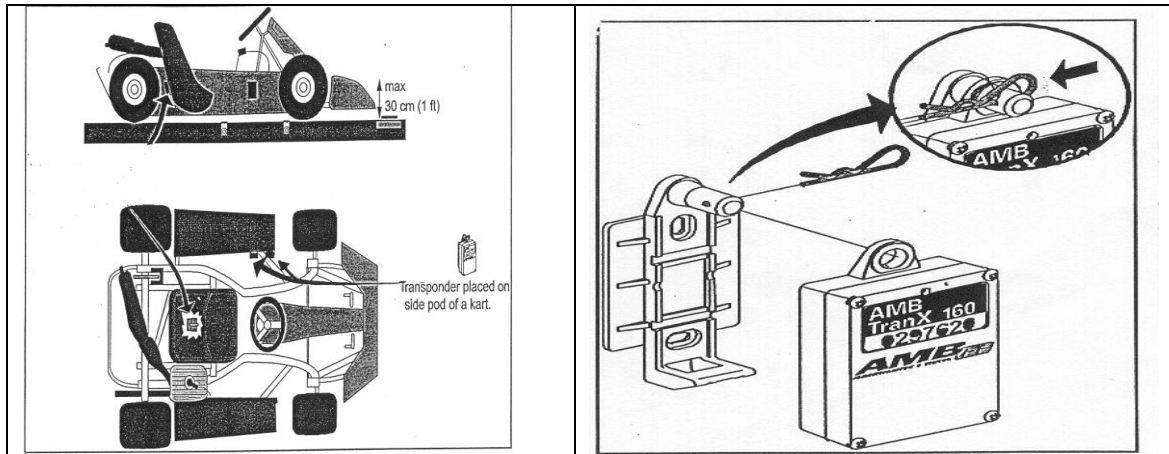

Scrutineering

- ▶ Cylinder head and exhaust sealing nuts are required.
- ▶ Correctly fitted Transponder Holder to suit AMB TranX 160 timing system is required – Transponder holders will be available on the day at a cost of \$10 each.

Pitting / Passes / Sealing Tags / Security / Canteen

Pit passes and sealing tags will be issued at Confirmation of Entry.

Pitting from trailers or vehicles will be limited and restricted to designated areas only.

Security will be provided Friday and Saturday evenings.

Canteen will be open Friday, Saturday & Sunday with breakfast available on Saturday & Sunday.

PLEASE NOTE:

- **Parking of motor vehicles is not permitted in the designated pit area.**
- **Smoking or welding is not allowed in the designated pit area.**
- **Dumping of Fuel is only permitted in drums provided.**
- **Animals are not allowed**
- **No riding of scooters or bikes permitted.**
- **Camping is not permitted.**
- **Hire Marquees are not to be erected without the knowledge & approval of the GKC**
- **It is a condition of entry to display sponsor decals on karts as directed by the promoter.**
- **Lost or damaged transponders will be the responsibility of the driver and / or entrant and will be charged by the Geelong Kart Club for the cost of repair and / or replacement**
