ENTRY PROCEDURE

Each Entry for this Meeting will be made using the KOMP as follows:

- Log on to your driver information via the Karting Australia Licencing and Events Portal or App
- Select the Event from the Event Calendar
- Enter the required details to complete your Event entry

Payment of the Entry Fee can only be made via KOMP.

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY:

- Eligibility is limited to drivers who are holders of a current A, B or C Grade KA licence or drivers that hold a licence issued by another ASN that is recognised by KA.
- D grade or provisional licence holders are not eligible to enter.
- Refusal or acceptance of entries is in accordance with General Rules, Chapter 1 Rule 17.
- The promoters reserve the right to abandon, postpone or cancel any event as in accordance with the Rules.
- NO LATE ENTRIES WILL BE ACCEPTED.

MINIMUM ENTRIES (Competition Rules, Chapter 5 Rule 4 l)

If less than 10 genuine entries are received to constitute a Class by the listed close of entries, then the Class may NOT be contested. All drivers whose entry is not accepted for any Class shall be notified as soon as possible and entry fee will be returned.

NOTICE BOARD ENTRY CONFIRMATION AT THE START OF THE RACE MEETING

In lieu of an administrative checking session, an Official Entry List including transponder numbers will be posted on the Official Notice Board the afternoon of 1/08/2024.

It is the responsibility of the Competitor to ensure that all information on the Official Entry List is correct. Any inaccuracies or discrepancies are required to be notified to the Chief Timekeeper no less than 60 minutes prior to the start of Practice for their respective Class.

PRIZES:

Trophies will be awarded in accordance with the provisions of Competitions Rules, Chapter 5 Rule 4 u). 1^{st} , 2^{nd} and 3^{rd} to be awarded trophies.

GENERAL REGULATIONS

KART RETRIEVAL:

Pit Crew with trolleys will be given access to the Track during Qualifying and Racing. Retrieval is at the discretion of the Clerk of the Course.

Pit Crew must only enter the Track when permitted by the Grid Marshal and then only if wearing a **HIGH VISIBILITY SAFETY VEST** in accordance with the Rules.

Karts can be retrieved via access through the Out Grid only.

VIDEO RECORDING SYSTEMS - Recording Medium (SD Card) Procedures

- a) It is compulsory for all Competitors to fit a camera to their Kart in a working condition from the start of the first practice session at this Meeting. Failure to do so will result in Disqualification of the Competitor from the next practice session. In the event of it being the final practice session of the day the Competitor will start from the rear of the grid in qualifying.
- b) A separate SD Card must be used for each Class contested at this Meeting.
- c) Prior to the commencement of on-track activity on each day of a Round, the Recording Medium used in the camera fitted to a Kart must be completely cleared and reformatted.
- d) No recorded vision on the Recording Medium may be deleted from the time that on-track activity has commenced on each day of a Meeting until 0700 hours the next day, without the prior written permission of the Stewards. It will be mandatory for each Kart competing to have a video recording system that is mounted in accordance with these Rules and be fully operational at all times while the Kart is on the Track: Technical Rules Chapter 1 Rule 8.

SCRUTINEERING:

Scrutineering for this Meeting will be in accordance with Technical Rules, Chapter 6 of the 2024 KA Manual. In accordance with the provisions of the Technical Rules, Chapter 6 of the 2024 KA Manual, each Kart shall have affixed to it a correct scrutineering sticker or identifying mark supplied for the Meeting. This signifies that the Driver has confirmed their entry for the Meeting and completed a Scrutineering Form relevant to the Entry.

As from 2/08/2024, the Grid Marshal / Scrutineers shall not allow any Kart that does not display a correct scrutineering sticker or identifying mark to Practice, Qualify or Race. Failure to comply will result in the Driver being excluded from the Meeting.

FRONT FAIRING (Technical Rules, Chapter 1 Rule 8 g) (iii): The Front Fairing Fitment Rules Will be used at this Meeting.

ENGINE SEALING AND CHASSIS TAGGING:

Each engine and Chassis must be sealed and tagged in accordance with the provisions of Technical Rules, Chapter 6.

TIMING TRANSPONDER FITTING INSTRUCTIONS:

MYLAPS compatible transponders must be mounted in accordance with Technical Rules, Chapter 1 Rule 8 i)

Note: All Karts MUST have fitted and correctly charged and operating transponders for all sessions commencing 2/08/2024

SECURITY:

Security will be provided from Thursday 1st August to Sunday 4th August 2024. Security will be onsite from 7pm each day. The Pit area will be locked each night between 8pm and 6am

PIT ALLOCATION: VEHICLE / TRAILER ACCESS

- Groups/Teams of more than five Drivers who are combining resources will be given preference.
- No oversize trailers or vans with single entries allowed in main pit areas
- Each entrant will be allocated one pit space of approximately 3m x 3 m per entry. They will be provided information on their location upon arrival at Circuit on Thursday August 1st, 2024.

TEMPORARY FACILITIES/STRUCTURES

- 1. Your attention is drawn to General Rules Chapter 4 Rule 21 Temporary Facilities/Structures Rules (the "TFS Rules")
- 1. Type A Structures as detailed in the TFS Rules are permitted to be erected at this Meeting.
- 1. Type B Structures as detailed in the TFS Rules (i.e. with a floor plan between 18 sqm and 36sqm) Will Not be permitted to be erected at this Meeting unless specifically approved by the Club.
 - The Structure must be properly secured to the ground in accordance with the TFS Rules.
- 1. Unless specifically approved by the Club, Type C Structures Will Not be permitted to be erected at this Meeting.
- 1. All Structures must only be erected in areas approved by the Club
- 1. All Structures must be properly secured to the ground in accordance with the TFS Rules

PARKING

There is to be NO vehicles inside the complex that aren't directly incorporated into a pit area. **ALL VEHICLES ARE TO BE PARKED IN THE CAR PARKS PROVIDED on Cook Street or Todd Road.**

DO NOT EXPECT TO DRIVE IN AND DROP OFF EQUIPMENT EACH MORNING.
