



## Key Works at Webb Dock this week

**MONDAY 2 NOVEMBER TO 8 NOVEMBER 2015**



### THIS WEEKEND - TODD ROAD CLOSURE

**8pm Fri 6 Nov to 5am Mon 9 Nov**

Detour via Salmon Street. Alternative freight routes will apply during this closure.

**Night works 6pm to 5am Thu 5 Nov**

Lane closures will apply along Todd Road to allow road preparation works prior to the full closure on 6-9 November. Works may be audible, however the contractor has scheduled works to progress from south to north away from residential homes.

### Other Road and Services Works

Works continue on the excavation and re-coating of a section of the gas and fuel pipelines as well as installation of the corten panels onto the Todd Road noise wall south of the West Gate Freeway.

### Maritime Works

Piling at Webb Dock West **will only take place during normal construction hours** i.e. **Mon-Fri 7am to 6pm and Sat 7am to 1pm.**

Non-piling out of hours works are taking place:

- Weeknights 6pm to 10pm and Saturday 1pm to 5pm - Webb Dock East and West
- Sundays 7am to 5pm - Webb Dock East

Internal transport movements at night within the port area only are continuing, along with a number of day time transfers during off peak (nil impact on traffic). Compliance with EPA noise guidelines is mandatory for out of hours works. All contractors are required to monitor noise levels. **24/7 queries: 1800 451 056**

### Operator Works

Rollers will be used in the off dock and empty container park area north of Williamstown Road from time to time. Impact rolling in the terminal area will take place on 9 November. Some noise and vibration may be experienced by nearby residents. **Queries regarding vibration impacts only should be directed to VICT on 8672 3284.** VICT are required to respond, investigate and where possible resolve concerns. Other concerns to be responded 24/7 by the Corporation on 1800 451 056. Out of hours works, compliant with EPA noise guidelines, are planned for Saturday 7 November, with contingency plans for Sunday.

### Webb Precinct Roads


